This is a great active physical game that reinforces the concept of big and small as well as encourages children to follow the directions.

To play this game, take children outside and tell them one statement at the time. Talk about the object that they found and provide descriptive words.

Hug something bigger than you.	Go touch the biggest thing you see.	Sit on something that is very very big.
Put something very small into a bucket.	Show me something smaller than a bike.	Run to something that is bigger than a tree.
Jump on something that is very very small.	Touch something big and small at the same time.	Put something that is very small in your pocket.
Hide behind something that is very big.	Find something that is smaller than you.	Sit on something that is very small.
Hide something that is very very small.	Find something pretty that is very small.	Pretend to pick up something that is very very big.
Put a ball on top of something that is big.	Do a silly dance around something that is very big.	Put three small things into a row.
