## Materials

- A plastic jar with lid
- Something small that can move the paint around (marbles, etc.)
- Leaf printable (provided at the end of this post)
- Paint



## **Encouraging friendship through art!**

### The Process



Cut out leaf template.



Place template into jar with a couple of marbles.



Add a nickel size drop of paint into the jar and close the lid.

Have two friends take turns rolling back and forth to each other.



Remove the leaf from the jar. Talk to the children about how they worked together to make the leaf painting.

## Variations

- Using other templates (heart, square, or circle).
- Adding multiple colors (encouraging conversation on color mixing).
