

Music Wall



Collect a variety of objects that make nice sounds when you tap them. Pots, pans, buckets, tubes, wind chimes and empty containers work great.

Attach these objects to an empty fence. You can attach them using zip ties, wooden frames, string or over the door hooks and hangers.

Once items are securely attached be sure to provide drum sticks or wooden spoons for the children to tap the new instruments with. Talk about the variety of sounds the children can create by tapping faster or slower or harder or softer.

Vocabulary to introduce: instrument, sound, beat, rhythm.
