Baby Play Sensory Bag

Materials Needed:

Gallon Size Zip bag Hair Gel Glass Gems Rubber Animals Duct Tape

Squeeze an entire bottle of hair gel into the plastic bag, drop in a few glass gems, rubber frogs and lizards. Zip up the bag and then fold over the duct tape in half around the edges of the baggie. This keeps the baggie closed and prevents it from tearing.

It takes less than 5 minutes to make and maybe the least expensive toy.



Have your infant explore this bag with his hands. And don't be surprised if they will explore it with their mouth.

Like always please supervise your baby. Add words for baby's actions and name objects that child is exploring.
