

OUTDOOR LETTER LINE

This is a great way to bring literacy outdoors!



Buy two pool noodles from the Dollar Tree store or any other store. Using a sharp knife, cut the pool noodles into sections. I wrote the capital letters of the alphabet on the alternate colored pool noodles using a permanent marker pen.

Screw two screws into the garden fence, just above the child's eye level, so it is easy for children to see and reach. Attach a piece of washing line. I threaded the first 13 letters of the alphabet onto the line. I repeated the same process a little lower down on the garden fence for the remainder of the letters.

Use this letter line to find the letters of children's names, review the letters in the alphabetical order or use it to sing the ABC song.
